



2007 MLL Collegiate Draft Registration Form

The Seventh Annual MLL Collegiate Draft will take place on Thursday May 31st, 2007 at Stony Brook University in Stony Brook, NY. The draft will follow the Warrior Major League Challenge, an invitational event recognizing the top 40 senior lacrosse players from all divisions of NCAA play. The draft will air live on ESPN-U beginning at 8:00PM on May 31st, 2007. Attendance at the Warrior Major League Challenge and Collegiate Draft is by invitation only. If you have not been invited to attend, you must submit this form in order to be eligible for the draft.

2007 MLL Collegiate Draft Eligibility

National Collegiate Athletic Association:

If you currently have eligibility remaining in the NCAA after the completion of the 2007 season, you are not eligible to apply for this draft. Upon submitting this registration form you will forfeit any remaining NCAA eligibility. This draft is only open to players who have just completed their final collegiate season. Only fill out this form once your season is completely finished.

Men's Collegiate Lacrosse Association:

If you currently have eligibility remaining in the MCLA you are eligible to submit an application. Upon appearing on your first MLL Active Roster you will lose all MCLA eligibility. If you remain unsigned, and in the Player Pool, your MCLA eligibility remains intact.

2007 MLL Collegiate Draft Information

By submitting this form, you are declaring yourself medically fit for professional field lacrosse and eligible for the 2007 MLL Collegiate Draft. If you are found medically unfit due to a known medical precondition you will not be draft eligible until the 2008 season.

The 2007 MLL Collegiate Draft will include 5 rounds. If you are not selected in the Collegiate Draft, your name will subsequently be placed into the Player Pool where you will remain eligible to be claimed under MLL policies at any time throughout the regular league season. If you are

claimed from the Player Pool you will then be notified by the team. Submitting this entry form will NOT prohibit players from participating in the NLL, USCLA or National Team competition.

If you are drafted you will be required to sign a standard player contract before further participation.

You are free to contact each of the teams in the league to indicate interest, ability to travel and work commitments. No team may represent that a position on the Active Roster is guaranteed. If drafted, you will be notified by your team by June 1st, 2007.

FULLY complete and sign the entry form and return it to Major League Lacrosse. There are no fees to enter the 2007 MLL Collegiate Draft.
